

## LaCrosse Weekend Ride Details

Friday 7/15/22 – We will depart from the Kwik Trip on Hickory & I-41 in FDL sharply at 8am. (980 S. Hickory). We will head west, riding the Merrimac Ferry to cross the Wisconsin River, make a quick stop at Hise Rock, and of course, ride through Wildcat Mountain State Park. From there we will head to Wildcat Mountain Bar & Grill for lunch, then over to Peaceful Valley Haven ([tinybuildings.net](http://tinybuildings.net)) to check out the 1/6<sup>th</sup> scale structures. If time permits, we will run up to Grandad Bluff before settling into our hotel in LaCrosse. Approx. 220 miles from FDL. There is a family restaurant close by the hotel for dinner if you choose. Breakfast will be available at the hotel.

Hotel Details: Country Inn & Suites (2110 Rose St. LaCrosse) 608-781-5100. There is a block of rooms reserved under GWRRA. Cost is \$119 (single king) or \$129 (double queen) + taxes. Yes...LaCrosse is expensive!

Saturday 7/16/22 – Today will be a day of riding and sightseeing. We will ride north on the WI side of the Mississippi River and head back south on the MN side (crossing at Red Wing, MN). Lunch stop is planned on the MN side. Any interesting points we see on the way we will stop to check out. Today is an old school road trip! No plans, just a start and end point. We will end the day in Richland Center. Approx. 276 miles. There isn't much for food within walking distance of the hotel, so tonight might be an order pizza type of night. Breakfast will be available at the hotel.

Hotel Details: Ramada Richland Center (1450 Veterans Dr Richland Center) 608-647-8869. There is a block of single king rooms reserved under GWRRA. Cost is \$89 + taxes

Sunday 7/17/22 – We will take off from the hotel and head about 30 minutes to the Stevenson Museum ([townofstevenson.com](http://townofstevenson.com)) for a roughly 3 hour guided tour. Cost for the museum is \$15 per person CASH ONLY!!! After our tour, we will head to Rockton for an awesome chicken lunch, then ride back through Wildcat Mountain State Park on Hwy 33. As we head east, everyone can break off and choose their own route home. Approx. 200 miles +/-
